## **GUIDELINES FOR REFERENCE LETTERS**

St Andrew's Greek Orthodox Theological College requires an original hardcopy of at least one reference letter. Choose one or two people who can write thoughtfully and specifically about your personal character, your vocational intention and your mental and physical capacity to study at the Theological College. If you are only providing one letter of reference, then this must be provided by your father confessor or parish priest.

If you are an applicant from a Christian jurisdiction other than the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Australia then you are normally required to obtain a reference letter from your local bishop <u>and</u> your father confessor or parish priest.

Each reference letter should clearly indicate the title, name, and contact details of the referee. It may be written in either English or Greek, and should be securely attached to the completed application form.

Clergymen of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Australia should address their reference letter to the College Dean, His Eminence Archbishop Stylianos, adhering to protocol.

The letter must be typed on church/diocese stationery (where applicable), signed and dated.
