#### OVERVIEW

St Andrew's Theological College was officially opened on 23 February 1986. It was established in order to provide tertiary level education and training of Christian Orthodox clergy, theologians, lay teachers and ministers in order to meet the catechetical and pastoral needs of the Orthodox Church in Australia.

Membership of the Sydney College of Divinity (www.scd.edu.au), an Australian University College accredited by TEQSA, guarantees for St Andrew's a high standard of scholarly excellence and civil accreditation by the Australian Government.

## OUR MISSION

Through faithful adherence to the Orthodox Christian Tradition, the College strives to serve the Church and the broader community through theological education in the following ways:

- On-campus and online programs for candidates to the priesthood, scholars, teachers and lay people
- Promotion of in-depth theological research and reflection, including publication of the academic journal, *Phronema*
- Lectures, research seminars, workshops, conferences and retreats
- Scholarly and popular publications through St Andrew's Orthodox Press and other online resouces.



### COURSES OF STUDY

St Andrew's delivers a variety of accredited courses at both undergraduate and postgraduate level.

- Bachelor of Theology (4 years)
- Diploma of Christian Studies (1 year)
- Diploma of Liturgical Music (3-4 years)
- Graduate Diploma of Theological Studies (1 year)
- Master of Theological Studies (2-3 years)
- Master of Divinity (4 years)
- Modern Greek Classes (in Sydney)
- Clinical Pastoral Education (in Sydney)
- Cross-Institutional and Audit Study Options

Classes are offered in person on campus (day & evening) and streamed via Zoom video conferencing.



#### LIBRARY

The College library contains over 17,500 monographs, a growing collection of ebooks and online databases, and 200 periodicals, available in English and Greek.

It specialises in (Greek) Patristic texts, Eastern Orthodox doctrine and spirituality, and Byzantine music resources. The catalogue may be accessed online via the College website.

St Andrew's welcomes applications for admission to its courses from qualified students who wish to prepare themselves for priesthood or other forms of ministry in the Orthodox Church, such as teaching, chaplaincy, social welfare.


